Background

The grant for the second phase of the Building Stronger Universities programme has recently been approved by the Minister for Development Cooperation and the Finance Committee of Parliament. Implementation of the programme starts on 1 January 2014 and runs until 1 November 2016, and the grant is DKK 100 million.

Changes have been made to the programme design in the second phase, but the programme still builds on the principle of partnership between universities in Tanzania, Ghana, Nepal and Uganda and Danish universities.

The meeting is called to present the programme and the plans for the match-making process to interested researchers from Danish universities.
